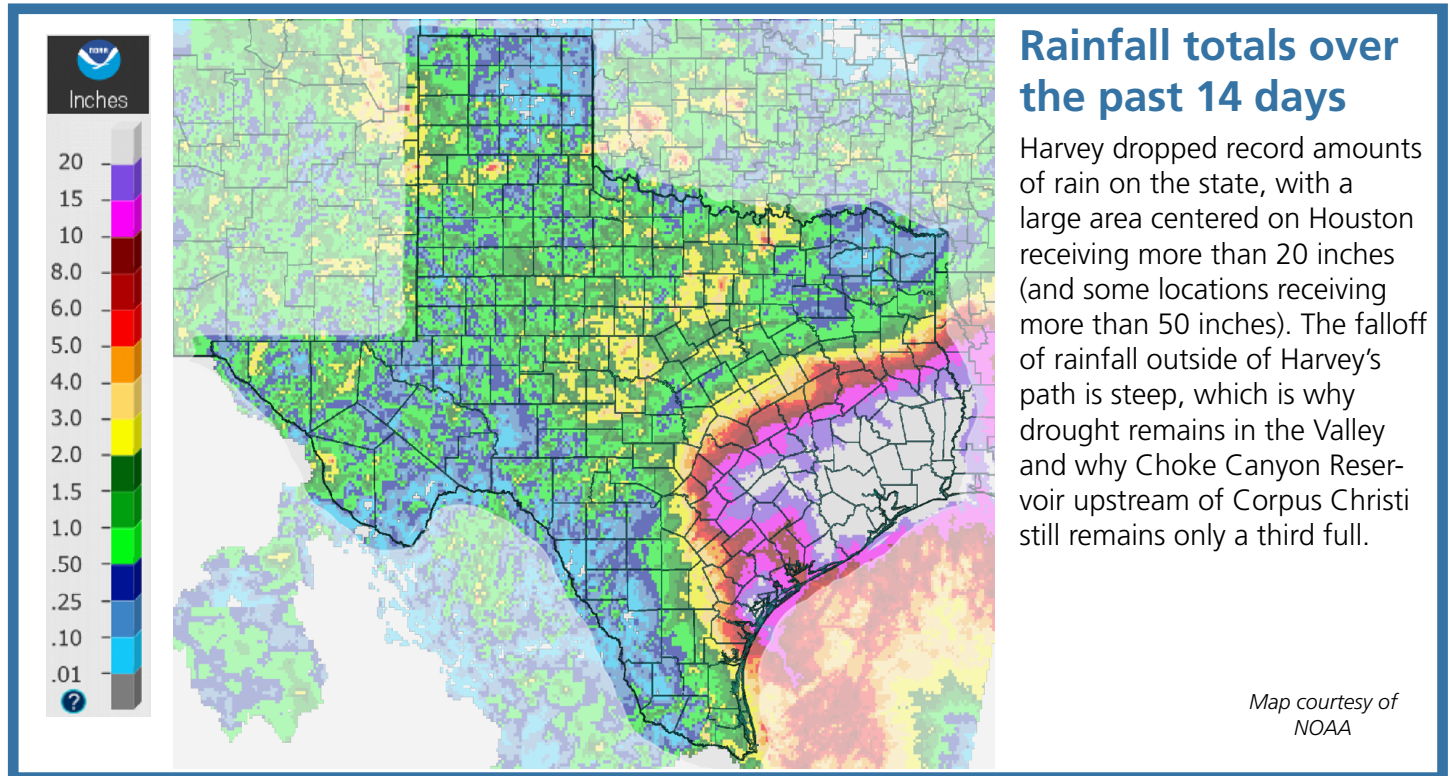
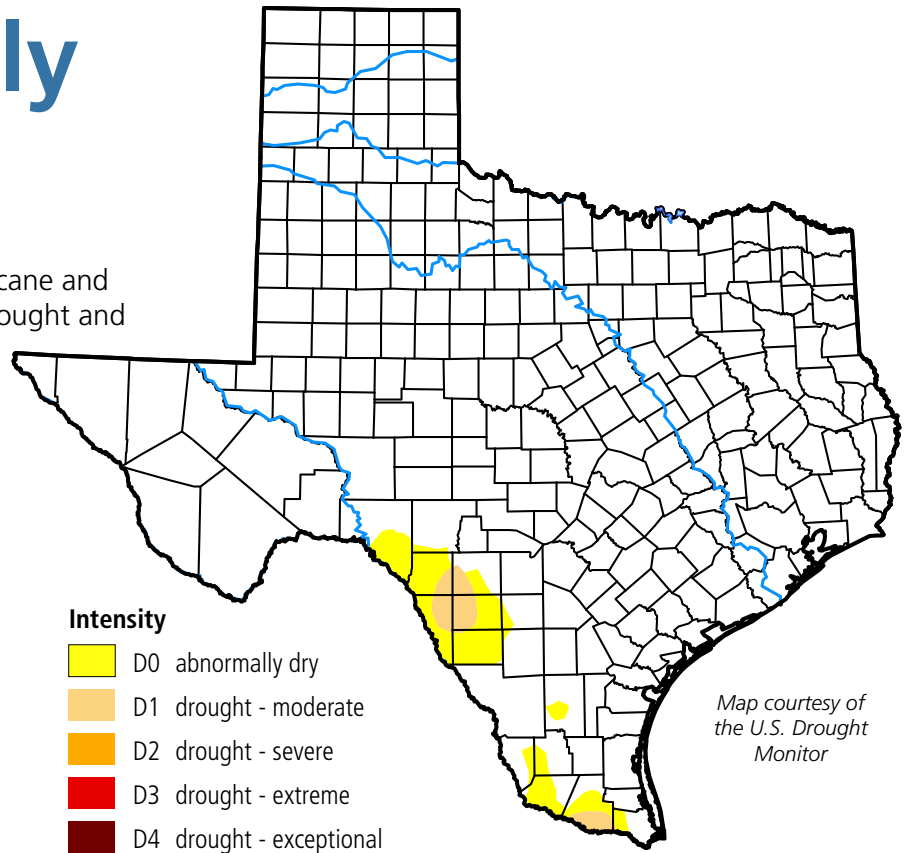

Water conditions

From a water-resource perspective, the hurricane and tropical storm forms of Harvey eliminated drought and filled reservoirs in the impact area. Harvey extinguished coastal drought conditions in much of the state; however, drought remains—and abnormally dry conditions expanded—in South Texas and the lower Rio Grande Valley.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 1% now
- ◆ 2% a week ago
- ◆ 4% three months ago
- ◆ 2% a year ago
