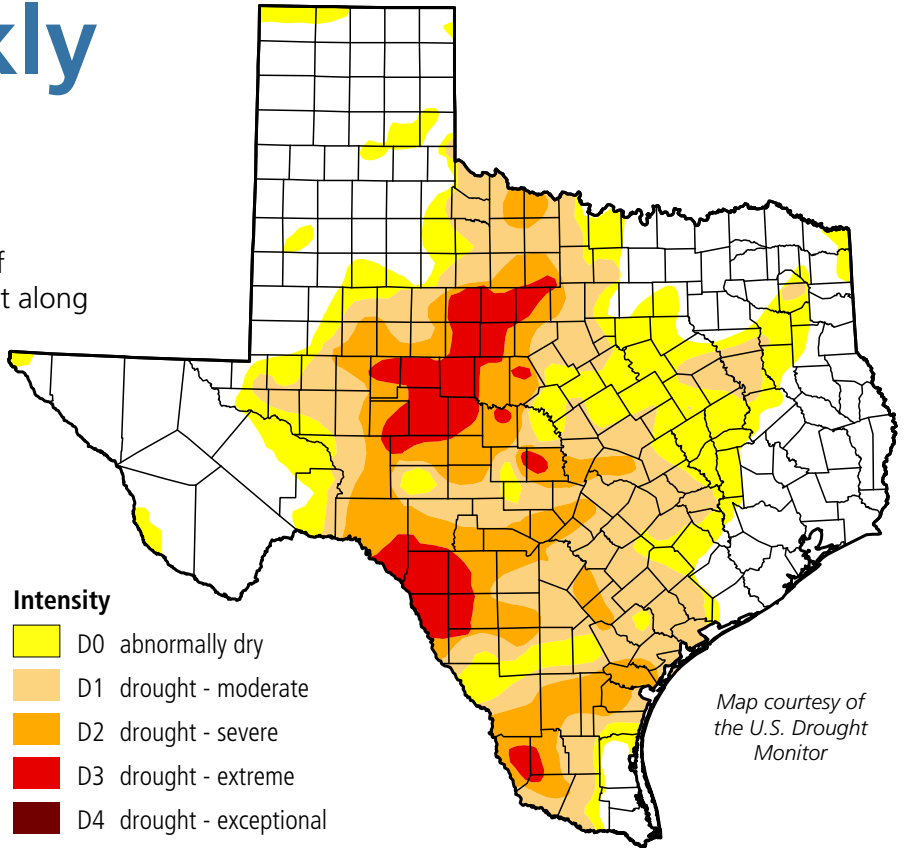

## Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of November 5 shows continued improvement along and east of the I-35 corridor. Extreme drought expanded near San Angelo, made a return to South Texas, and now impacts 6 percent of the state.

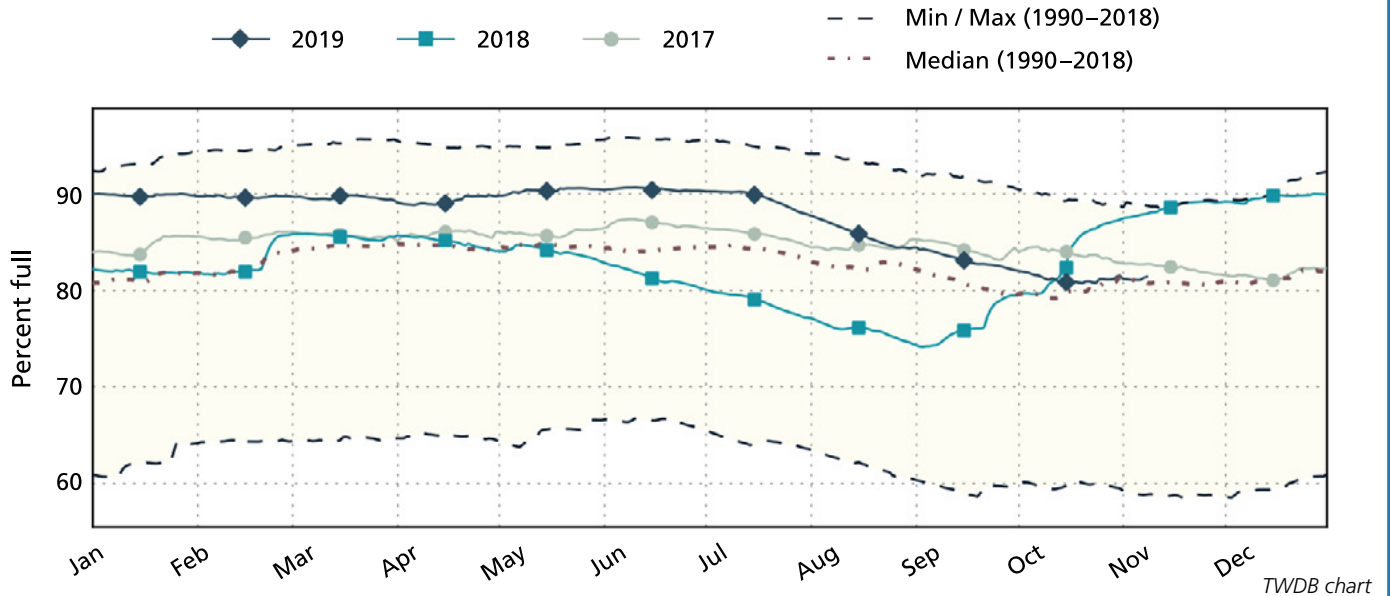
## Drought conditions

- ◆ 41% now
- ◆ 47% a week ago
- ◆ 10% three months ago
- ◆ 1% a year ago



## Statewide reservoir storage

In a typical year, our statewide water supply reservoirs lose about 5 percentage points of their volume from the beginning of July to the end of October. This year, we've lost 9 percentage points during that time. Statewide, our current storage is normal for this time of year.
