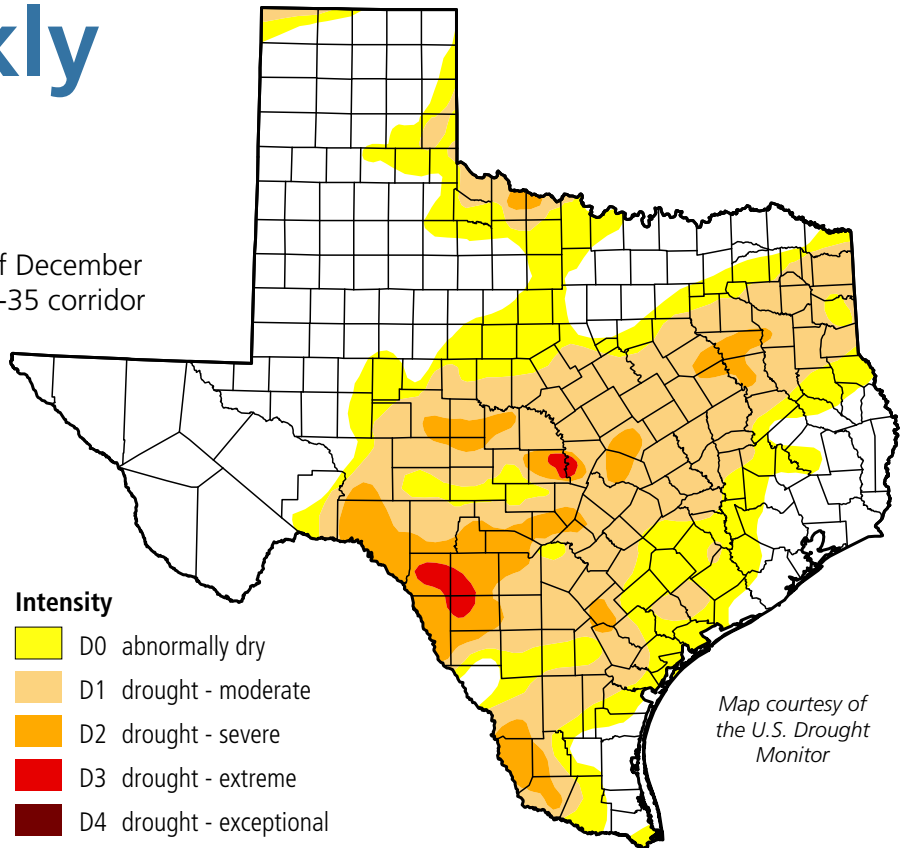

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of December 10 shows some improvement west of the I-35 corridor offset by worsened conditions in South Texas and east of the I-35 corridor. Statewide, moderate or worse drought conditions ticked up 1 percentage point.

Drought conditions

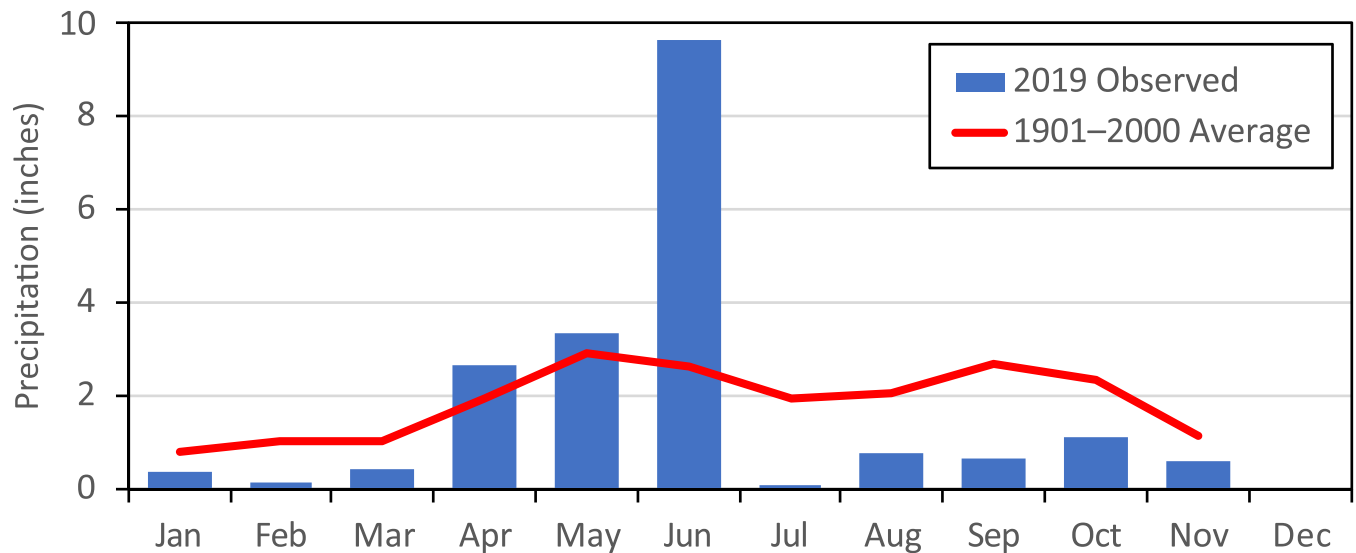
- ◆ 35% now

Kinney County precipitation

In June 2019, precipitation for Kinney County was 9.66 inches, a new record for the month. In the five-month period from July to November 2019, the county received only 3.26 inches of precipitation, the lowest amount for that period since 1952 and the second lowest amount in 125 years.
