

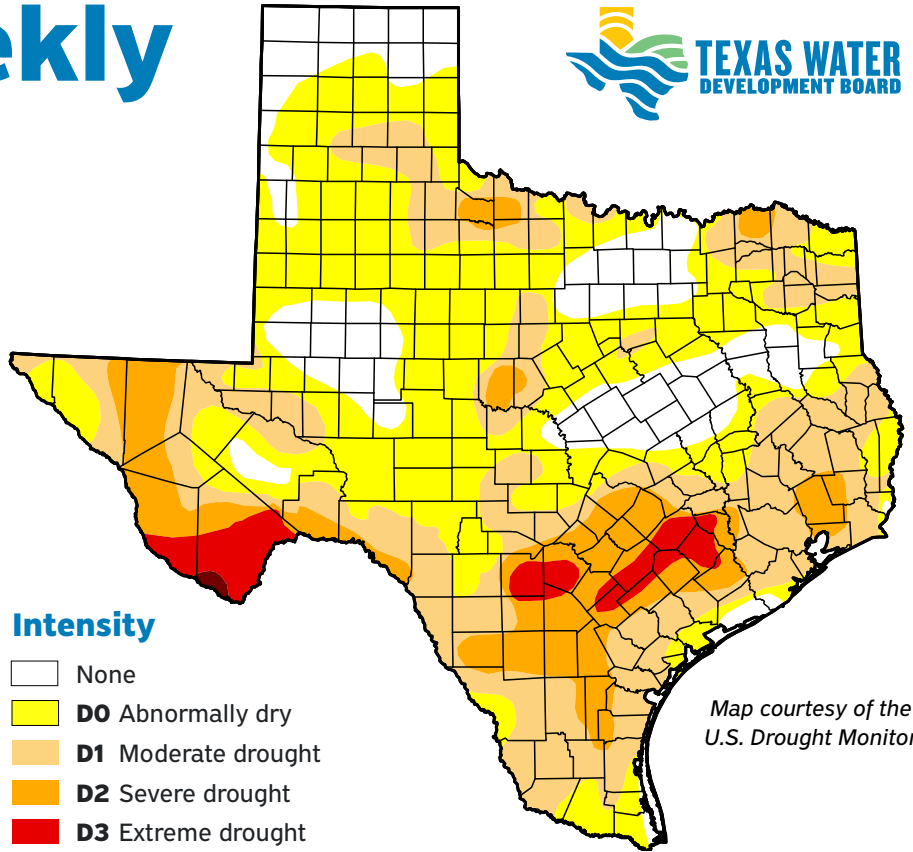
Water Weekly

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of November 4 shows an increase in drought area from the previous week, the seventh weekly increase in the past eight weeks. The area of the state impacted by drought has reached a six-month high. Expect more drought on next week's map.

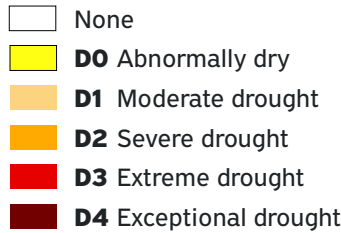

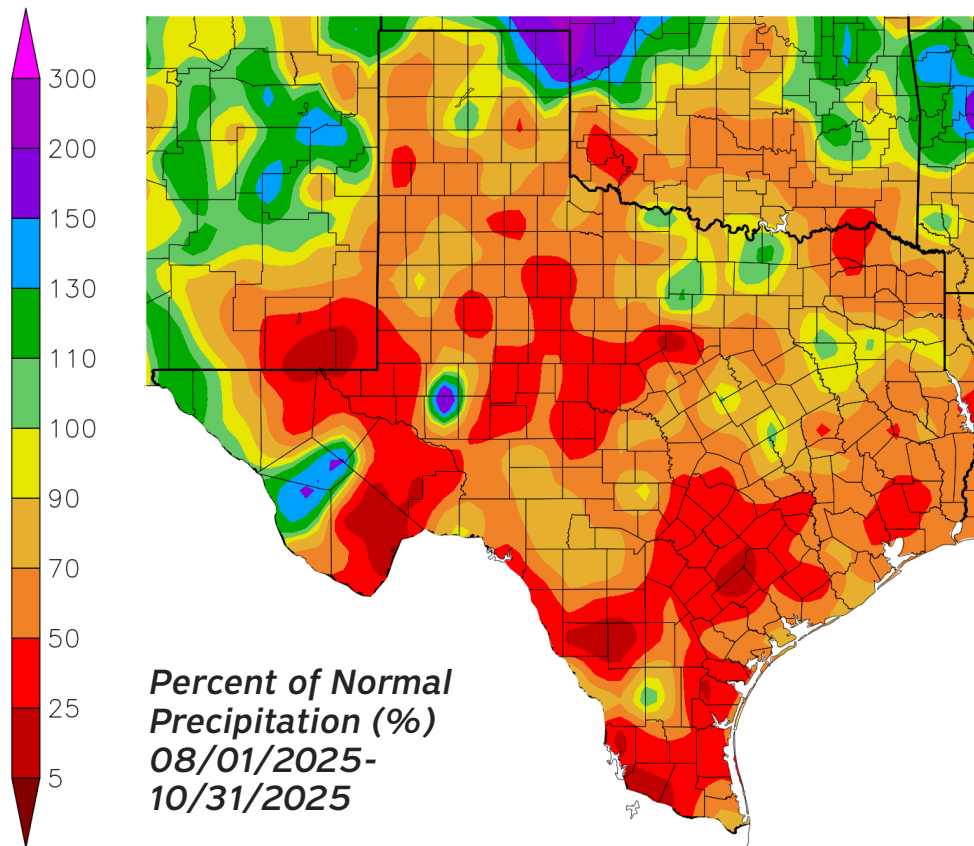

August-October precipitation

Over the last three months, precipitation has been well below normal for most of the state. Large areas of the state have received less than half their normal rainfall for August through October. Only a few scattered areas have received normal or better rainfall.
