

MAJOR MUNICIPAL RESERVOIR SYSTEM STORAGE

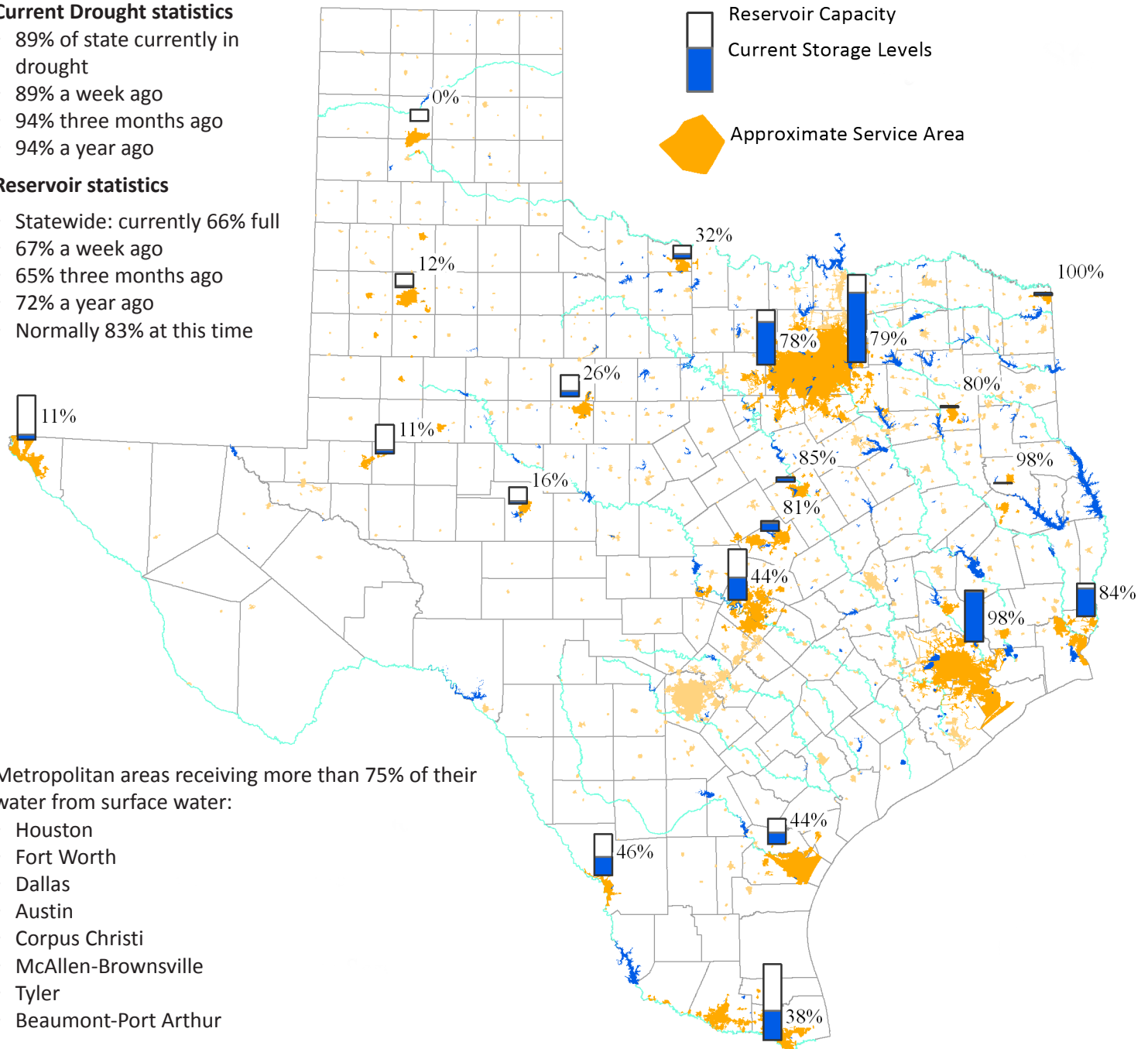
This week's drought report highlights the 20 largest metropolitan areas that receive more than 5% of their water supply from surface water. It also shows current storage levels in those reservoir systems.

Current Drought statistics

- 89% of state currently in drought
- 89% a week ago
- 94% three months ago
- 94% a year ago

Reservoir statistics

- Statewide: currently 66% full
- 67% a week ago
- 65% three months ago
- 72% a year ago
- Normally 83% at this time



Metropolitan areas receiving more than 75% of their water from surface water:

- Houston
- Fort Worth
- Dallas
- Austin
- Corpus Christi
- McAllen-Brownsville
- Tyler
- Beaumont-Port Arthur
