

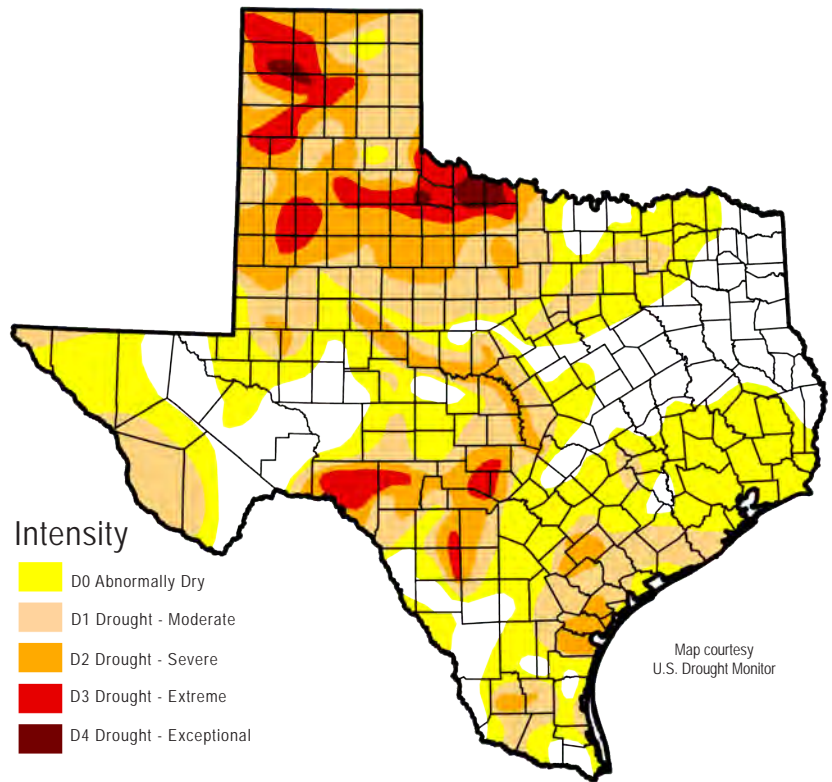
DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Drought conditions essentially holding but with a troubling development over the weekend: State-wide reservoir levels are now again setting new lows for data going back to 1990. We are 2.5 percentage points lower than we were a year ago and 15 percentage points lower than normal.

Rain, where art thou?

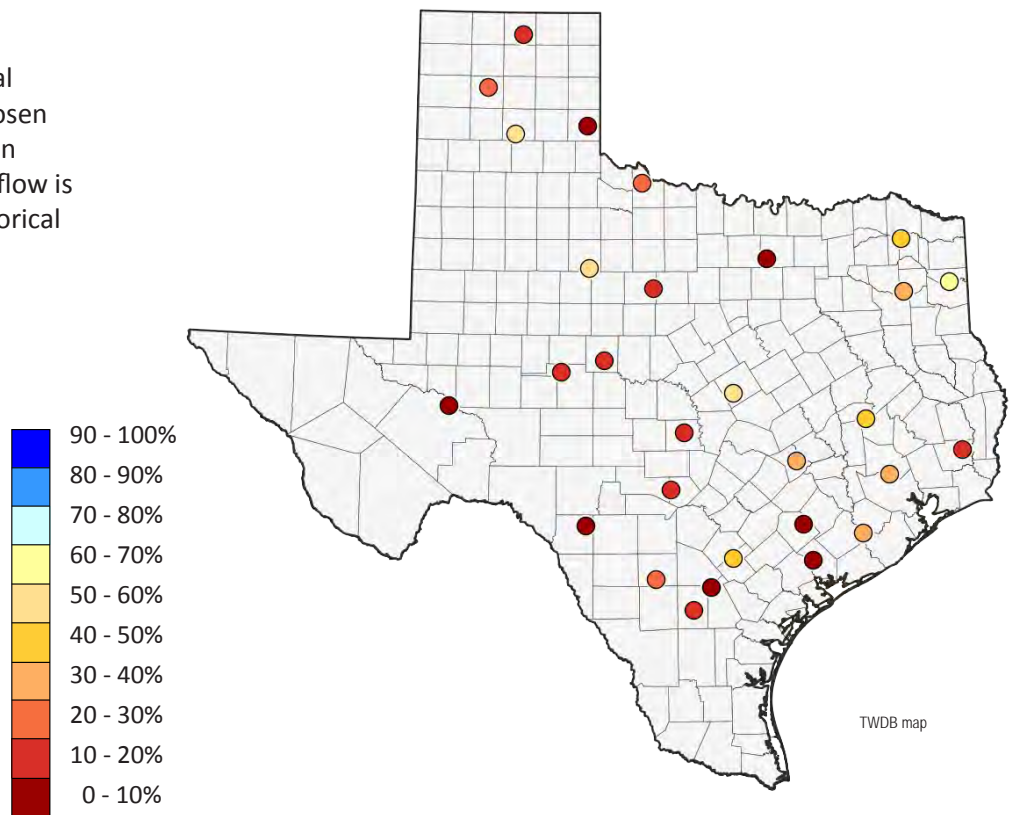
Current drought statistics

- 46% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 44% a week ago
- 62% three months ago
- 74% a year ago



STREAMFLOW

Twenty-nine United States Geological Survey streamflow stations were chosen to represent streamflow conditions in Texas. For each day, 30-day average flow is presented as a percentile of the historical record for that calendar day.
