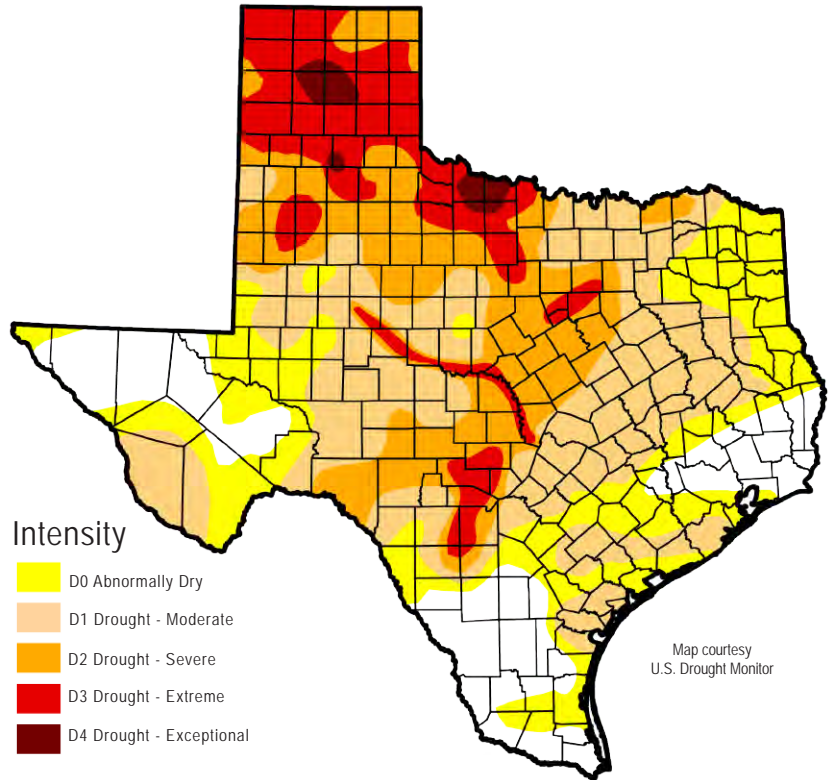


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Continuing a trend from the previous week, less of the state is in drought, but the drought has intensified in other parts of the state, particularly in the panhandle. The new U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook map, good through the end of June, shows a removal or improvement of drought conditions in east Texas with persistence and development in west Texas.

Drought statistics

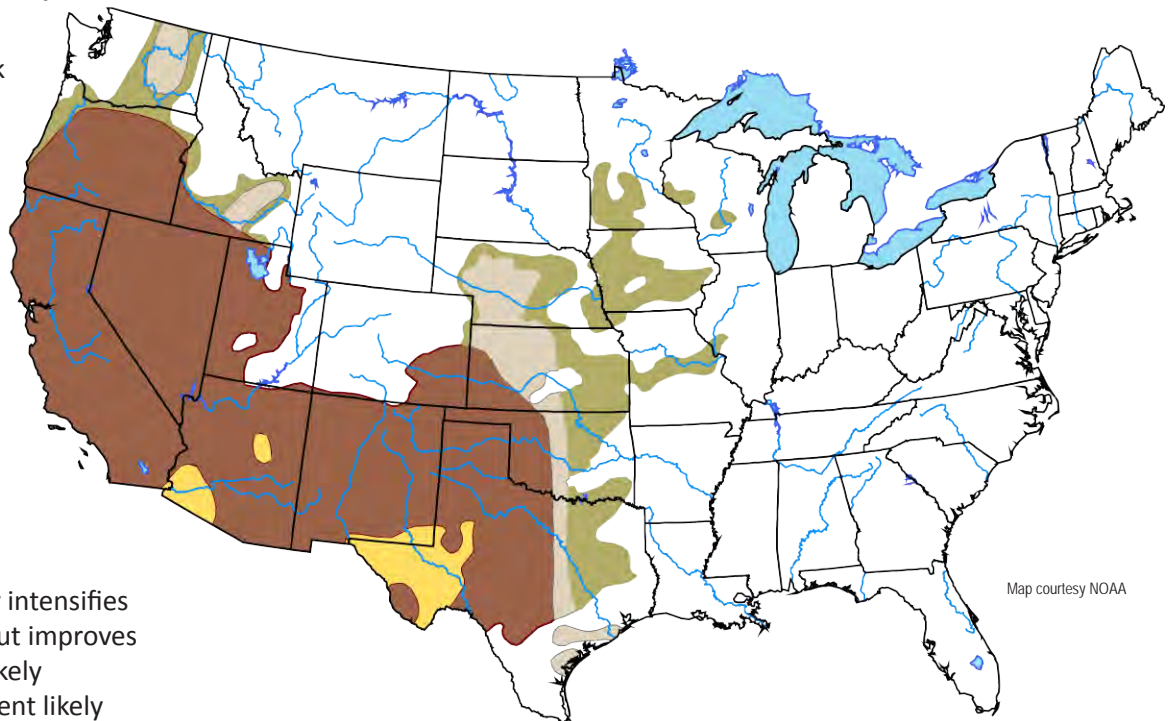
- 64% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 63% a week ago
- 47% three months ago
- 85% a year ago
