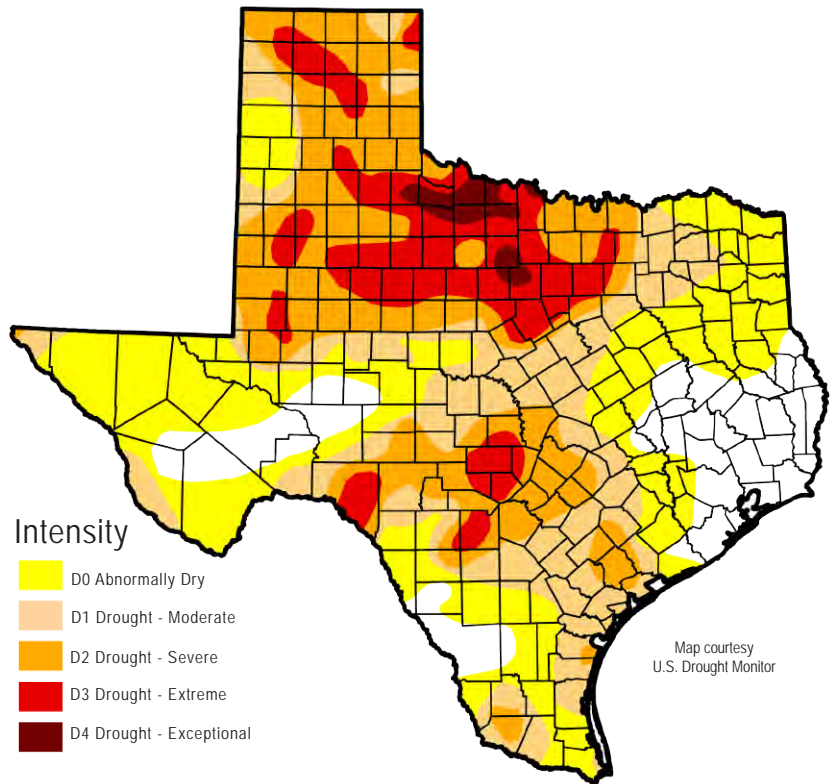


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Rains over the past week resulted in improved drought conditions, particularly in West Texas and the Lower Rio Grande Valley. Nevertheless, statewide reservoir storage dropped by 150,000 acre-feet. The prognosis for more rain over the next week is promising, so perhaps we can reverse downward reservoir trends sooner rather than later.

Drought statistics

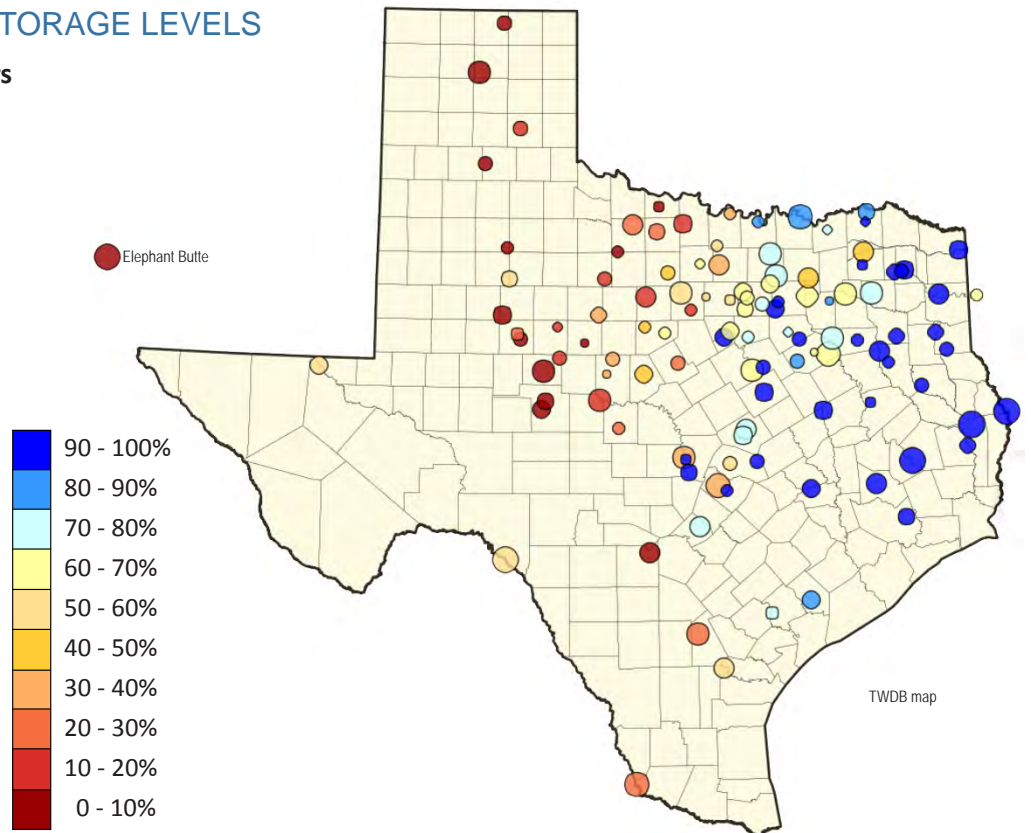
- 58% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 61% a week ago
- 69% three months ago
- 87% a year ago



STATEWIDE RESERVOIR STORAGE LEVELS

Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 64% full
- 64% a week ago
- 67% three months ago
- 59% a year ago
- Normally 79% at this time
