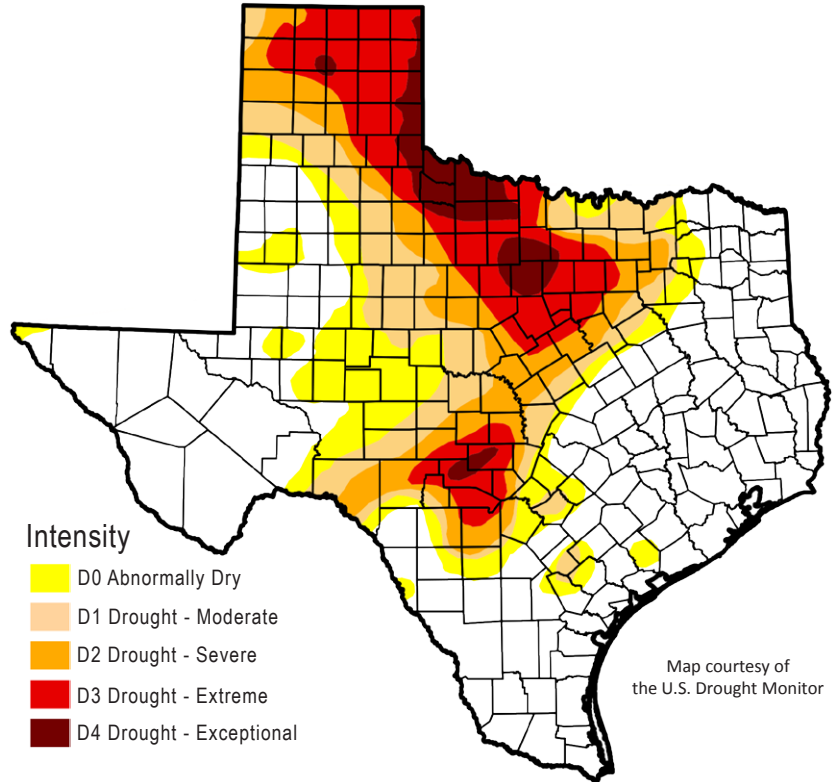


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS

As of Thursday, statewide drought and reservoir conditions were relatively unchanged over the past week with a slight squeak toward continuing improvement. However, drought conditions remain or worsened and reservoir levels decreased in West Texas up through the Panhandle. Rains from the weekend are expected to bring continued statewide improvements.

### Drought statistics

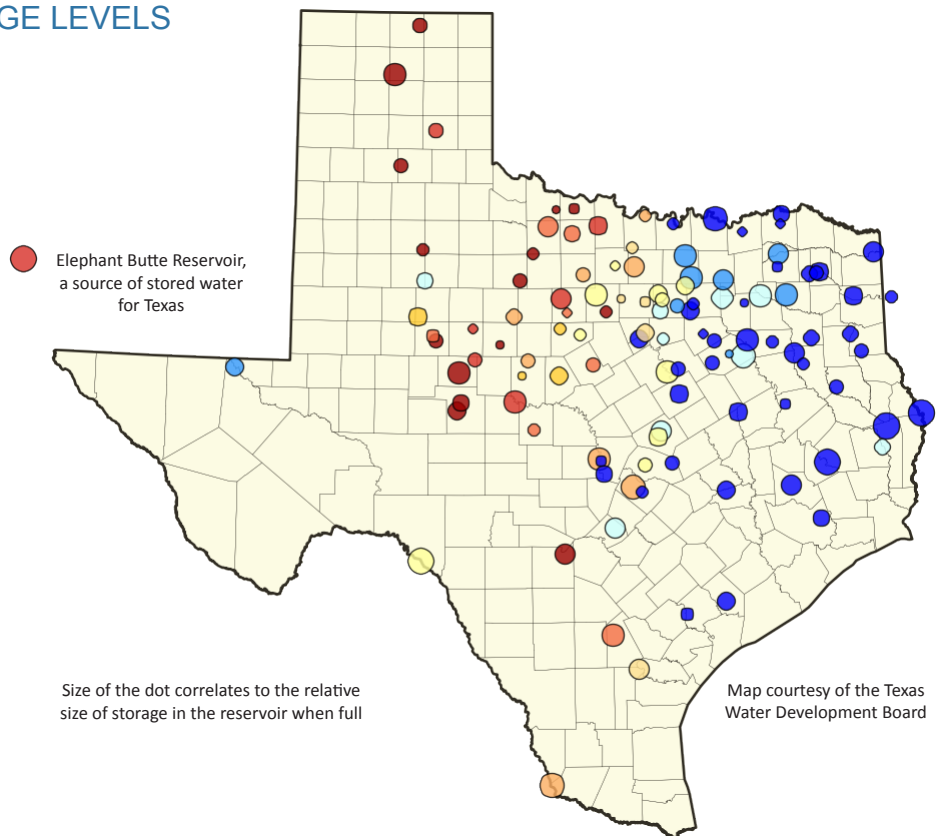
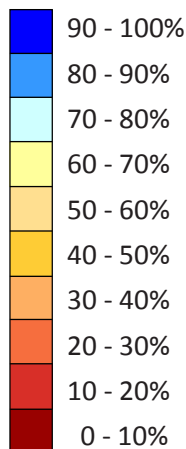
- 36% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 37% a week ago
- 42% three months ago
- 64% a year ago



## STATEWIDE RESERVOIR STORAGE LEVELS

### Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 70% full
- 70% a week ago
- 64% three months ago
- 65% a year ago
- Normally 83% at this time
