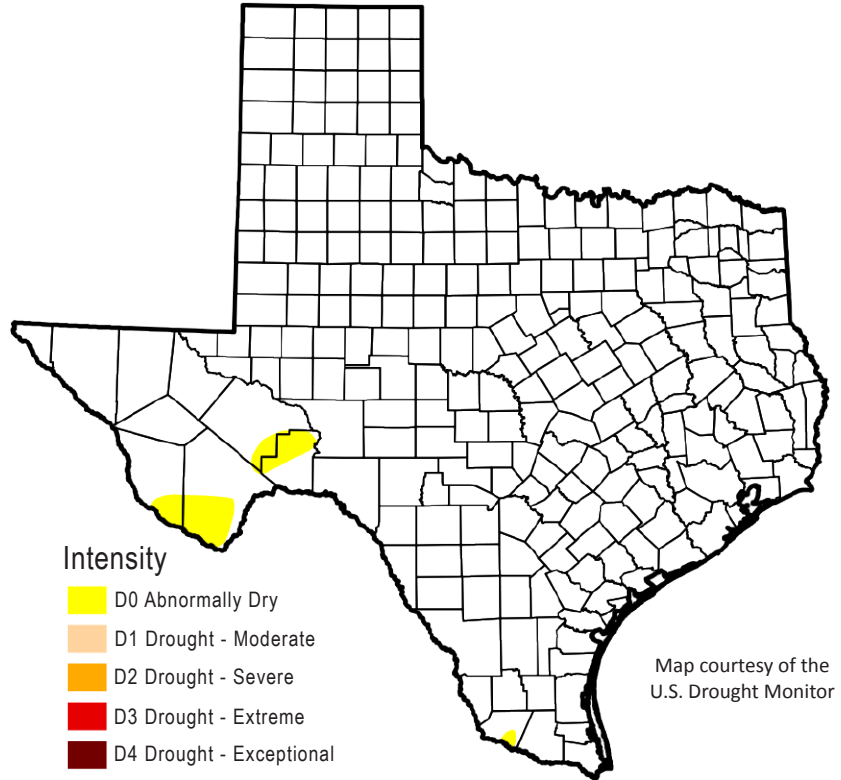


WATER CONDITIONS

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, we are in week six of a drought-free Texas; however, reservoir levels in west and south Texas continue to be below normal. Abnormally dry conditions (the transition to and from drought) are less than 2 percent of the state, the lowest since August 2007.

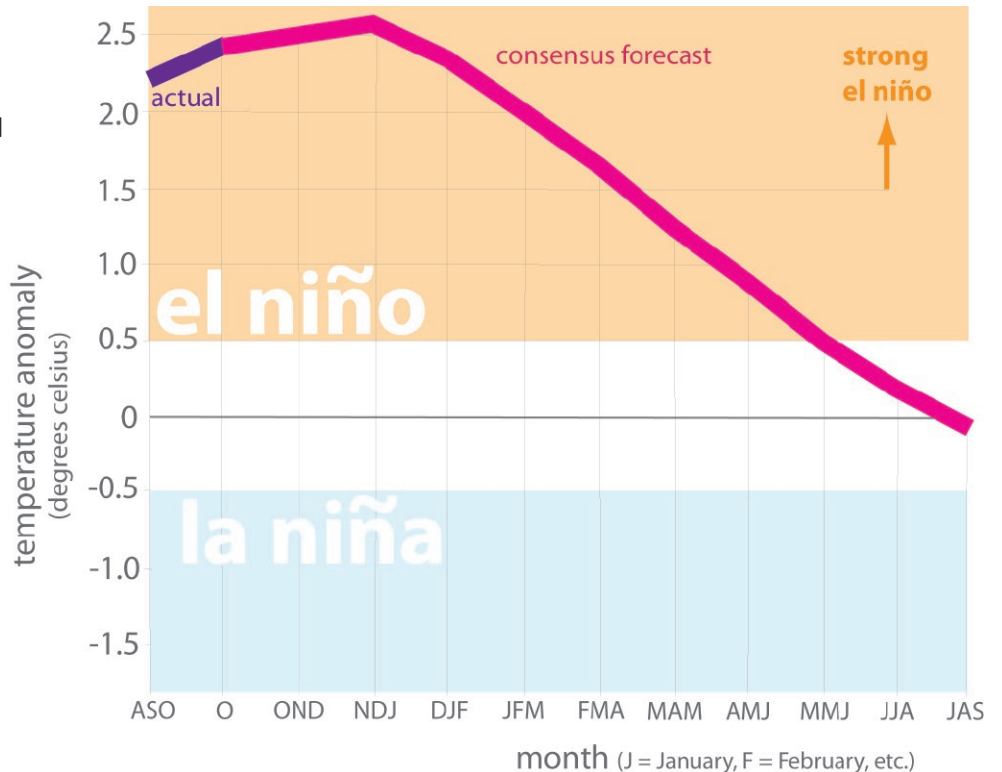
Drought conditions
