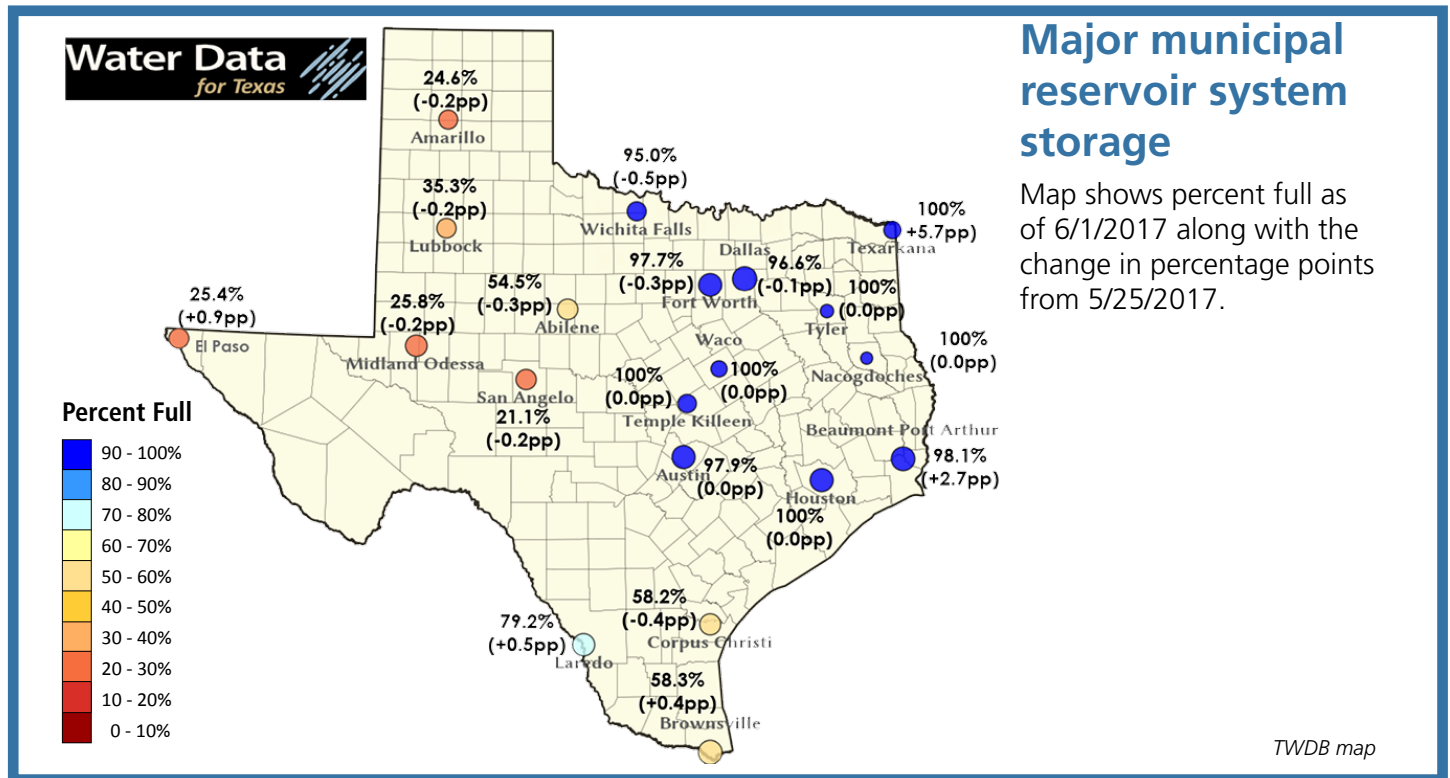
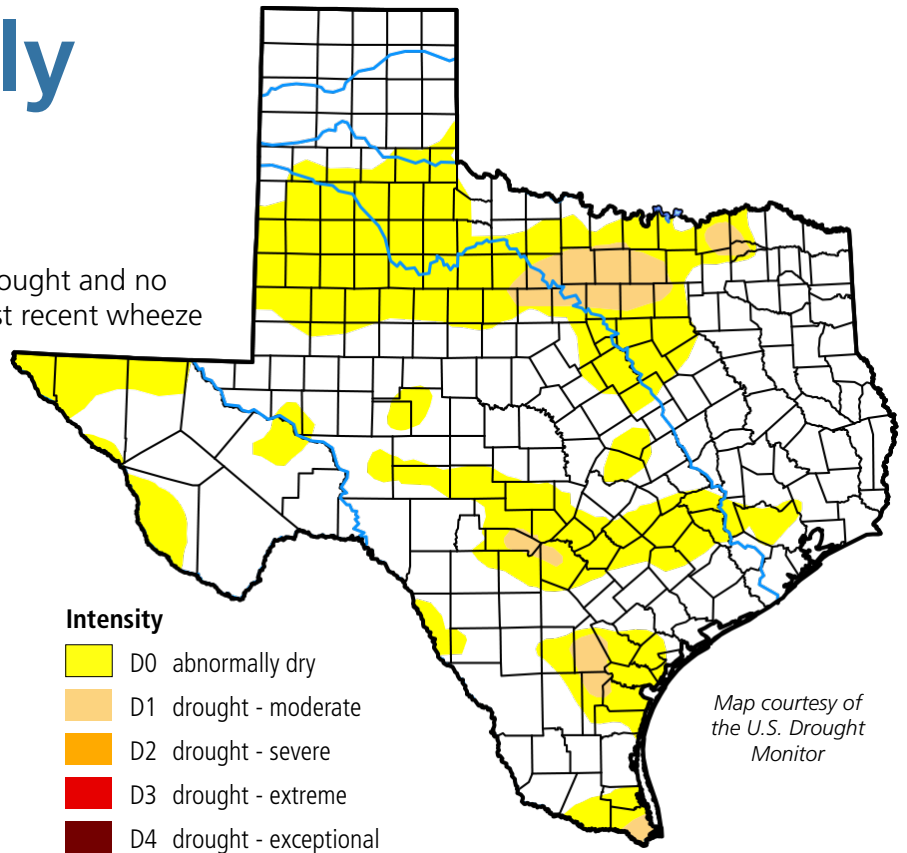

The past month has been an accordion of drought and no drought conditions. As of last week, the most recent wheeze of the climatic squeezebox brought us expanded drought conditions in north and central Texas with some improvements in the Lower Rio Grande Valley and in the south, central, and north central parts of the state.

- ◆ 4% now
- ◆ 2% a week ago
- ◆ 4% three months ago
- ◆ 0% a year ago
