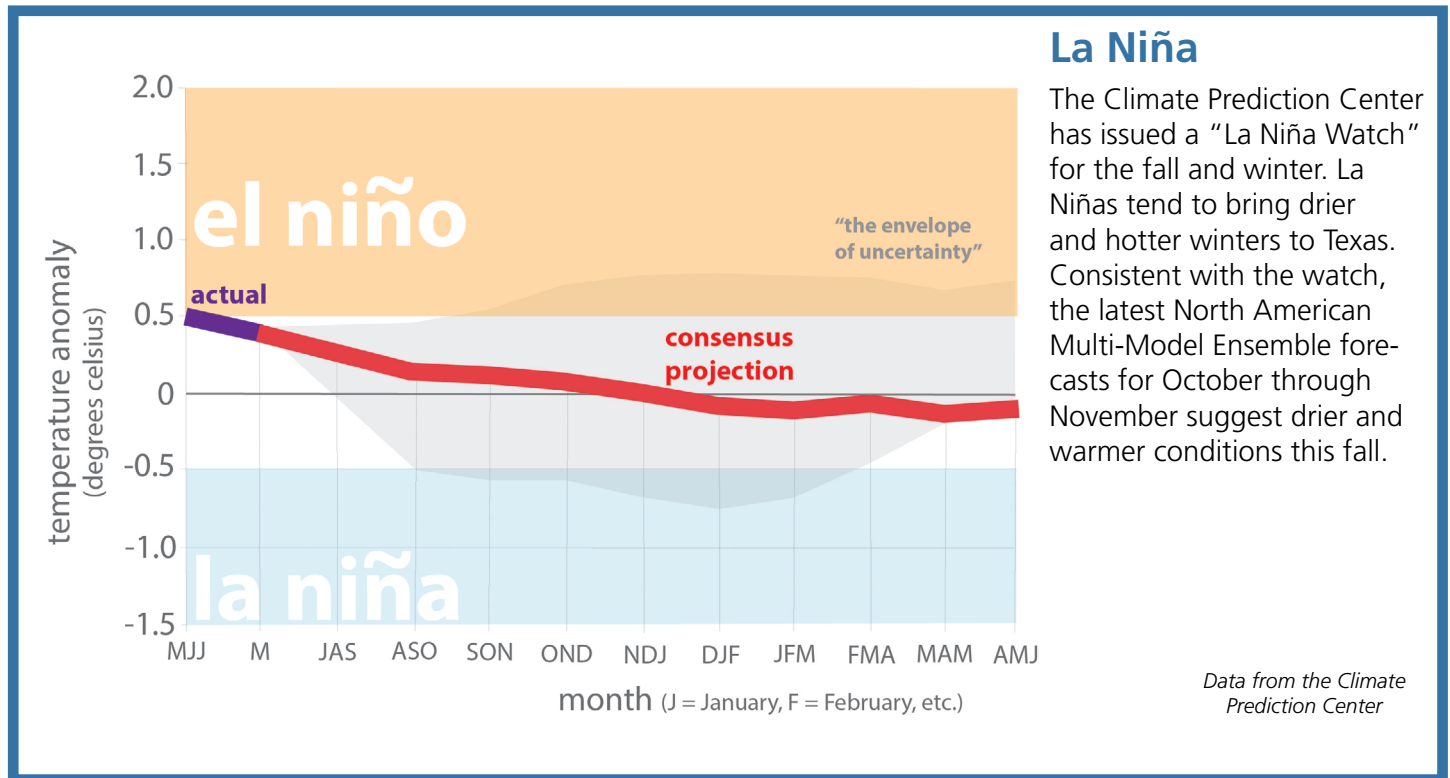
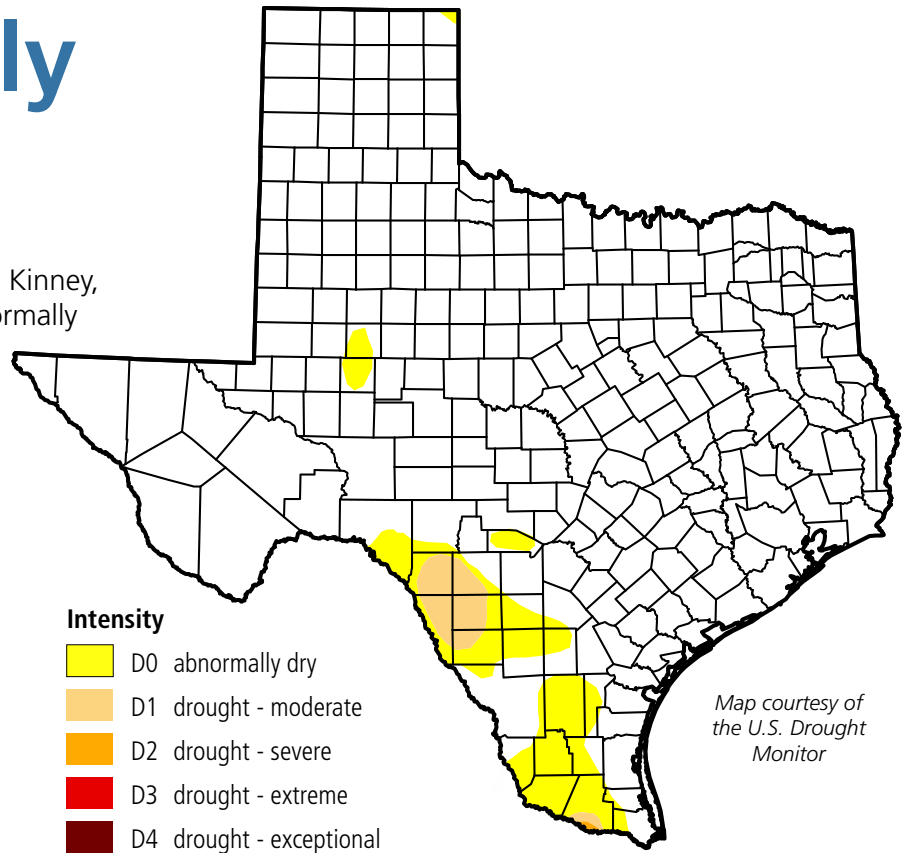

Water conditions

Drought expanded in South Texas in Dimmit, Kinney, Maverick, Uvalde, and Zavala counties. Abnormally dry conditions expanded in the lower Rio Grande Valley and appeared in Bandera County. During the last 30 days and over a distance of less than 100 miles, Caldwell County received six times its normal rainfall, and Medina County received less than a quarter of its normal rainfall.
