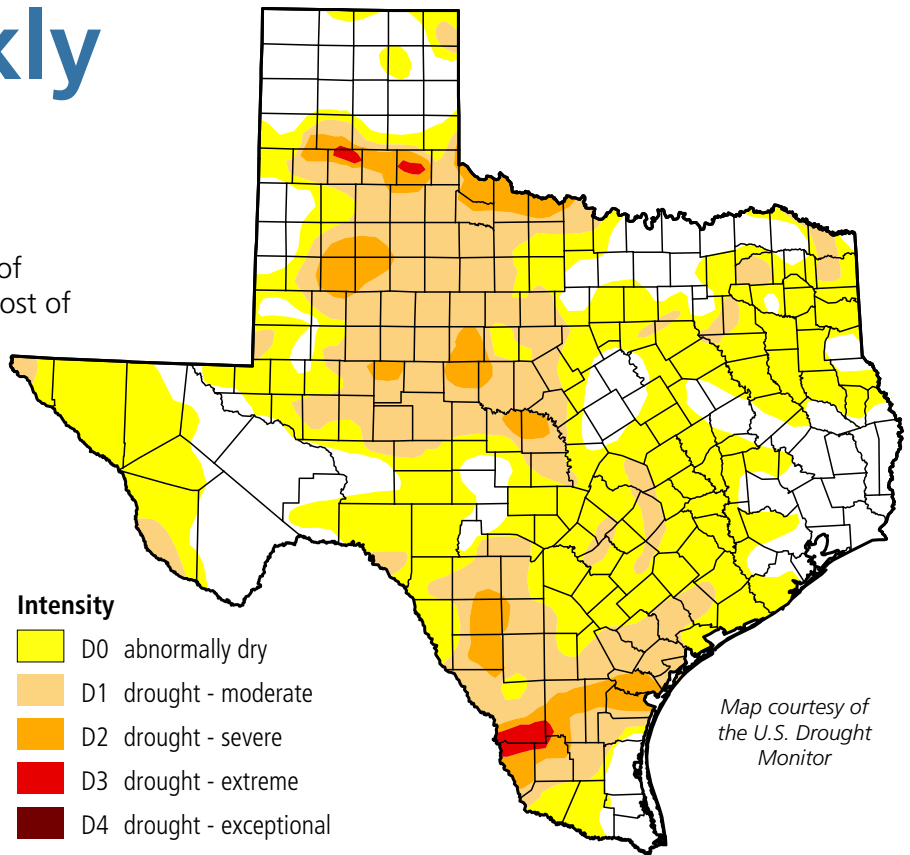

## Water conditions

The latest drought map shows the impact of continued hot and dry conditions across most of the state. Moderate or worse drought increased by 10 percentage points. Extreme drought expanded in the south and emerged in two new pockets in the upper Red River Valley.

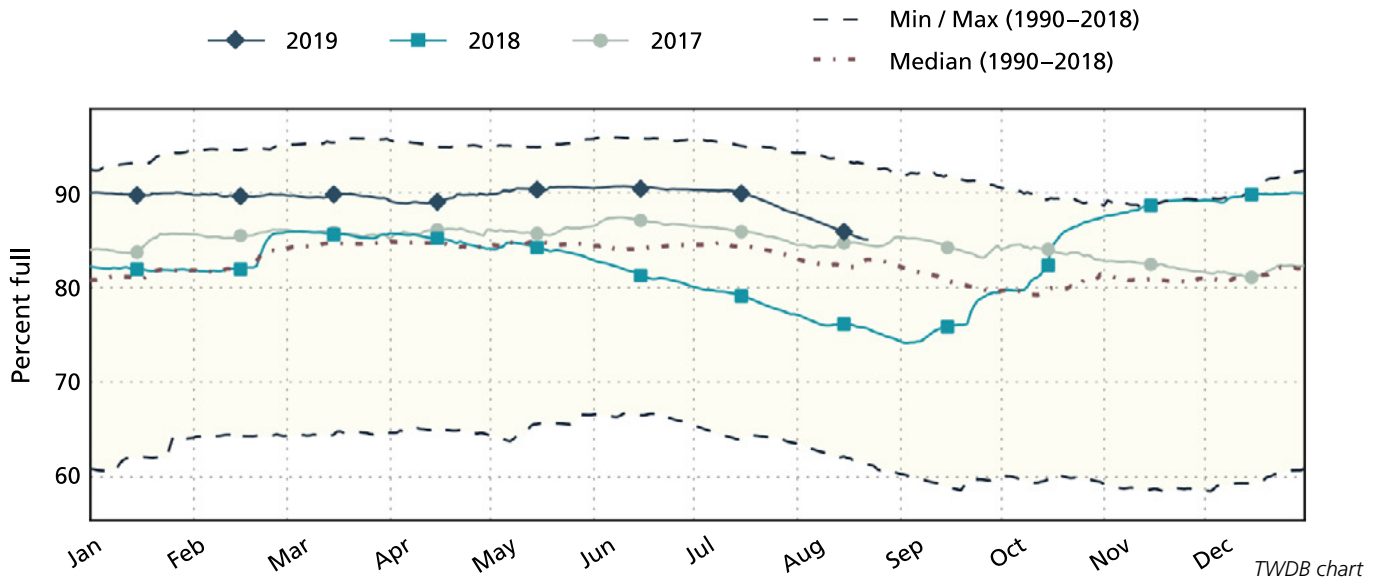
## Drought conditions

- ◆ 32% now
- ◆ 22% a week ago
- ◆ 0% three months ago
- ◆ 60% a year ago



## Statewide reservoir storage

In a typical year, our statewide water supply reservoirs lose about 2 percentage points of their volume from mid-July to mid-August. This year, we've lost 4 percentage points during that time. Statewide, our reservoirs are still about 2 percentage points higher than normal for this time of year.
