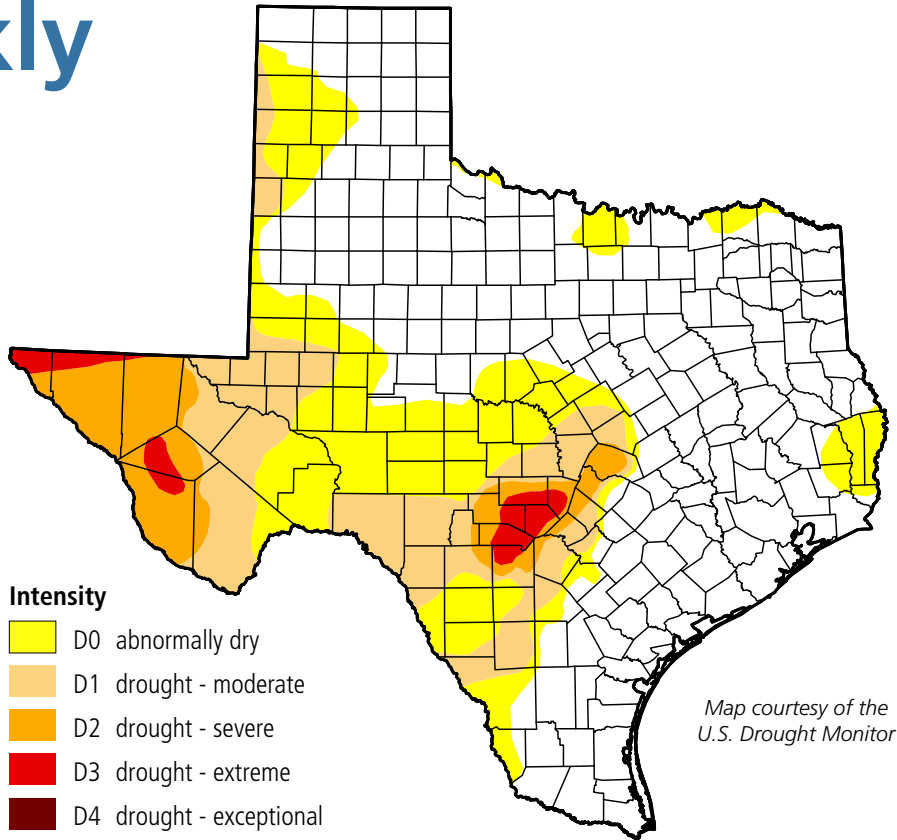

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of February 27 shows little change from the previous week. The area of the state impacted by drought was unchanged. The area considered susceptible to drought in the next few weeks, shown in yellow on the map, expanded a few percentage points.

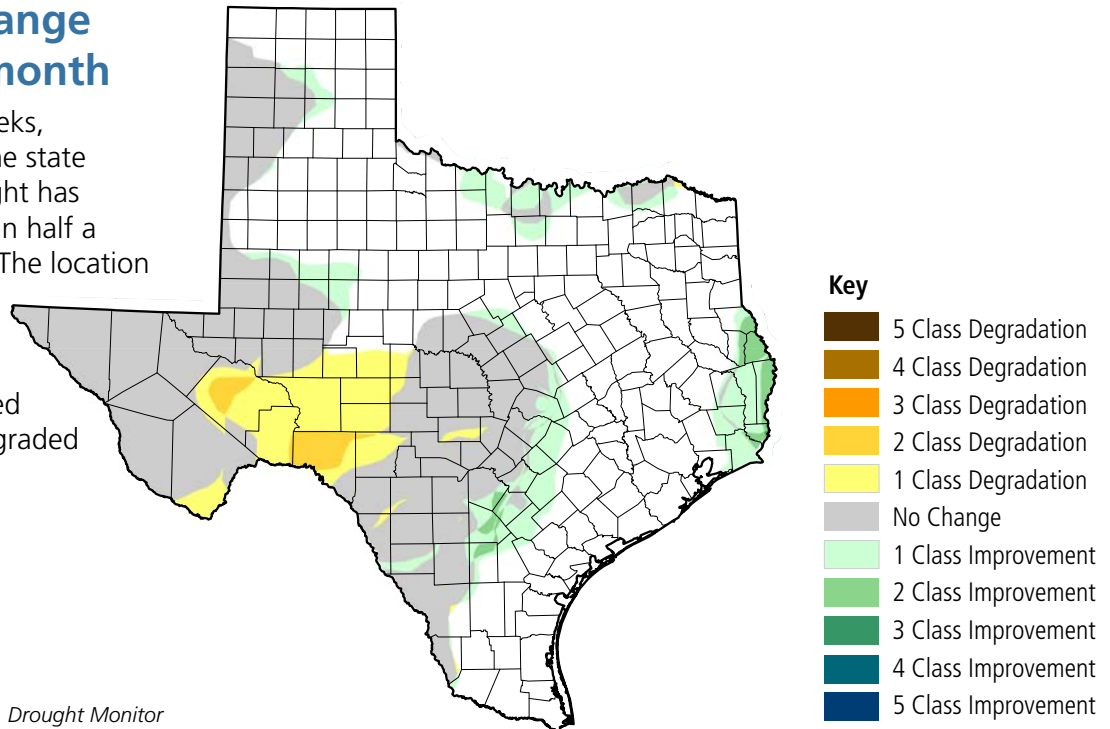


Drought conditions

- ◆ 23% now
- ◆ 23% a week ago
- ◆ 43% three months ago
- ◆ 62% a year ago

Drought change in the last month

In the last four weeks, the total area of the state impacted by drought has contracted less than half a percentage point. The location of drought in the state, however, has shifted as conditions improved in the east and degraded in the west.
